Minutes:

Opening Prayer- Pastor Will Wold

Call to Order- John Russell called the Council to order at 6:01.

Devotion- John Russell presented a devotion from *The One That Got Away*.

Introductions- Dan Davis introduced the Church Council Class of 2019.

Role of the Church Council- John Russell discussed the role of the Church Council as spelled out in the *United Methodist Book of Discipline*.

Past Stewardship of our Time, Talent and Treasure

- The November 6, 2016 minutes were approved.
- Dan Davis presented the nominations report.
- Jeff Hayes delivered the Finance Report.
 - The pledges for 2017 are still being accounted for.
- Chris Pillav delivered the Stewardship Report.
 - MUMC has received \$1.36 million thus far.
 - However, there is a goal of \$1.5 million for 2017.

- The Stewardship Committee is working on a way to make their presence felt year round.
- Pastor Debbie McLeod delivered the Pastor's Report.
 - o MUMC experienced an arson threat on December 13, 2016.
 - JSO was called and opened a case file for this incident.

Opportunities to Share our Time, Talent and Treasure

- Pastor Jeff St. Clair delivered an update on the CR 210 Initiative Longleaf @ 210.
 - Since the last Church Council meeting, there have been two community activities.
 - The marriage group gained four more couples.
 - Small groups are growing at a slower rate from the other events but still continue to see an increase in attendance.
 - o There are five more events planned for 2017.
 - John Russell co-leads a devotion group on Tuesday mornings.
 - Nick Morcom leads a group called Gospel 365.
 - Jenifer Linder is working to establish a Ladies Craft Night as a new Fresh Expression.
 - o Kayaking with Jeff is continuing to grow and see more community members.
- John Russell presented the Tactical Team update entitled God's Vision, Our Dreams.
 - Over the past 12 months the Tactical Team has been employing the Appreciative Inquiry tool in the MUMC visioning and planning process.
 - Through the AI process, the MUMC Family has indicated the strengths of the church lie in four categories: Worship and Sacraments, Discipleship, Meeting People Where They Are/Faith Sharing, and Serving Others.
 - He described the various activities/initiatives that would be implemented to leverage those strengths.
 - The Florida Conference has offered MUMC a grant over 5 years for \$500,000 to expand the capacity of MUMC beginning July 2017.
 - The Florida Conference has offered to offset a portion of the costs required to start up the *Longleaf* @ 210 Initiative beginning July 2017.
 - The Florida Conference has also offered to provide a Minister in Residence beginning in July 2017.

Closing prayer and Benediction - Pastor Debbie McLeod closed the Church Council meeting with a prayer and benediction.
