- Call to Order John Russell called the Council to order at 6:01pm.
- Opening Prayer Pastor Anna Scharbo
- Devotion Robin Overton offered a devotion based off the Council's reading from Canoeing the Mountains. She reminded us of Jesus' command to go make disciples of all nations.

Past Stewardship of our Time, Talent, and Treasure (Old Business)

- The minutes from the January 28, 2018 meeting were revised and approved.
- Jeff Hayes delivered a finance report on the revised budget for 2018 and the Council voted to approve revisions that featured:
 - Revenue reflecting a \$123,000 reduction.
 - Expenses reduced by about \$93,000.

Opportunities to Share our Time, Talent, and Treasure (New Business)

• The Council discussed the content of the first six chapters of *Canoeing the Mountains*, and what it means for MUMC and the environment in which we minister.

- Pastor Jeff St. Clair delivered a Longleaf Church update. The discussion centered around the answers to some frequently asked questions about this initiative. All these questions and answers can be found in the Longleaf Church Frequently Asked Questions FAQ Sheet.
- Dan Davis presented amendments to the nominations for 2018.
 - Jerry Reich's position on the Board of Trustees is being filled by Harold Fowler.
 - Henry Burkhard is filling the position of Safety Committee Chair.
 - Connor Wilson and Steve Putnum are joining the Safety Committee as well.
 - Because she is moving away, Michelle Natividad is stepping down from her place on the Endowment Committee, leaving a vacancy.
 - Julianne Tevlin is stepping down from her place on the Recreation Ministries Committee leaving a vacancy.
- Dan Davis presented our plan for The Way Forward. He and Glinda Spickelmire are leading three 'Point of View' sessions on April 18, 25, and May 2 to engage our congregation how to begin the discussion of human sexuality
- The Council was tasked with reading chapters 7-11 of *Canoeing the Mountains* for the next meeting.
- Pastor Debbie McLeod closed the meeting with a prayer and benediction at 7:49 pm.
